The Decodables Library loosely correlates to the Levelled Library.

Whichever **Reading Level** the student has **access** to, they will also be able to access the **correlating phase** in the Decodable Library.

Keep in mind: Even though this student has their Reading Level set to Blue, they will be able to see *all Decodable Phases*, because their **Level Access** is set to *All Levels*.
